## **Explanation of Responses:**

1. As previously reported, on January 5, 2011, Laurent C. Lutz was granted 100,000 restricted shares of the Company's common stock, which grant was approved by the Compensation and Personnel Committee (the "Compensation Committee") of the Board of Directors of SLM Corporation (the "Company"). One-third of these restricted shares vest on first, second and third anniversaries of the grant date. On January 5, 2013, an additional 33,333 shares of such restricted stock vested and 1,780 additional shares were issued to Mr. Lutz upon the vesting of the related dividend equivalent rights, of which 12,365 shares were withheld by the Company (as approved by the Compensation Committee) to satisfy Mr. Lutz's tax withholding obligations.
